TEMPORARY MEAL CARD INFO DURING 1st YEAR ORIENTATION

Because the Meal Management system is controlled and activated by your student card until the time that you formally register you will not have a student card. There is therefore a need to arrange a temporary card for the initial orientation phase.

Please see below how this process will work.

1st YEAR TEMP MEAL CARD PROCESS DURING ORIENTATION

- For the period 23rd January until the date you formally register you have a MAXIMUM daily limit of R50.00 for the purchase of ONLY meals and resale items (juices, crisps) etc. NO groceries, tobacco or toiletries will be allowed.
- This card has been loaded with the R500.00 that you have paid on arrival.

The R500.00 at a daily limit of R50.00 will allow you to purchase for a full 10 days. The card should be used for purchases at your residence dining room – or the dining room closest to you during your orientation programme.

- Please spend the full R500.00 on the card as there are NO refunds available.
- Once orientation has ended, please make sure you hand back the temp meal card by no later than the start of the first lecture or pay a penalty of R100.00.

WHAT if I have a problem with my card?

WHO can help me?

- If card is lost or stolen during this orientation period you will need to contact your Residence Manager for a new card, at a replacement cost of R100.00.
- Misuse of this meal system will lead to disciplinary action.
- Once you have registered you MUST return your temp card to the Residence Manager or you will pay R100.00 for a replacement card. Please hand back the card by no later than the start of the first lecture.
